

Carlow: ? place out of 53 towns / cities surveyed. Clean to European Norms.

Congratulations – A superb result overall - all sites surveyed in Carlow were Grade A. There were Litter Awareness and / or Dog Fouling notices at all of the sites surveyed – perhaps the constant reminder of same is having the desired effect? Clearly a very effective and efficient cleaning and maintenance process is in place, combined with respect by the users of the facilities / environment. Well down to all who work so diligently to present Carlow at its best and to the citizens who co-operate so enthusiastically.

Dublin Approach Road: Grade A. An excellent approach road into Carlow, setting a very high standard which was sustained for all the sites surveyed. All aspects along this road were in very good condition.

Athy Approach Road: Grade A. There was a complete absence of litter along this route into Carlow – a spotless site throughout.

Kilkenny Approach Road: Grade A. Another top ranking approach road – all aspects of the road surveyed were clean and well maintained.

Wexford Approach Road: Grade A. There were some road works taking place along this stretch of road but they didn't impact in any negative way on the litter situation. Despite high levels of traffic it was still a top ranking site.

Tesco Car Park: Grade A. Another very busy site which despite high levels of activity was clean and well presented. There were plenty of litter bins in the area surveyed.

Dublin Street: Grade A. The individual shop fronts along this street were very well presented and contributed to the overall appearance of this old street. The whole area was very well maintained.

Oaklands: Grade A. Both the public spaces and individual properties at this residential area were in very good condition.

Carlow Railway Station: Grade A. An excellent site where the staff have litter management well under control and station had plenty of litter bins.

St. Mary's Academy – Girls: Grade A. A Green Flag School which was living up to the ethos of the Green Flag - all aspects of the area surveyed were clear of litter.

Hazelwood: Grade A. A spotless residential environment where, despite the lack of bins, there was a complete lack of litter.
