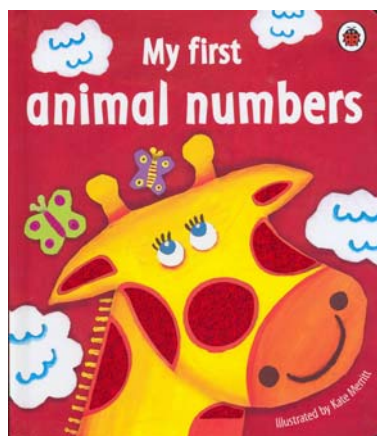

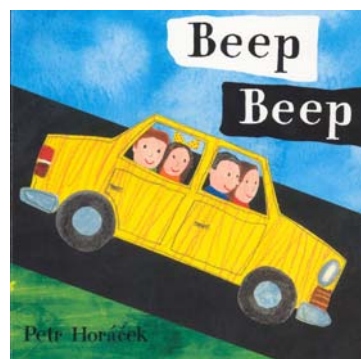
My First Animal Numbers



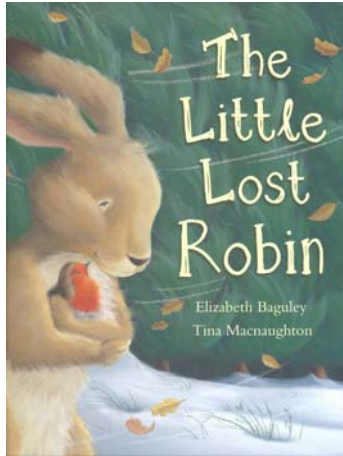
Young babies and toddlers will love recognising and counting all the different animals in Ladybird's My First Animal Numbers.

The Little Lost Robin by Elizabeth Baguley & Tina Macnaughton



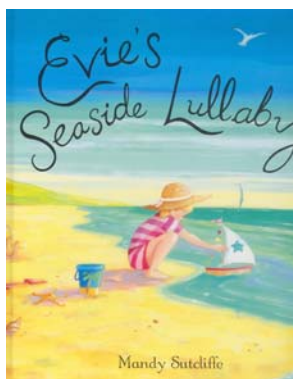

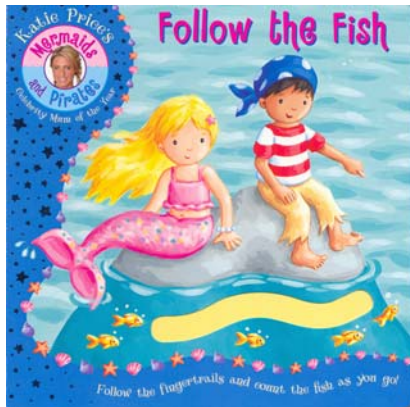


Evie's Seaside Lullaby by Mandy Sutcliffe

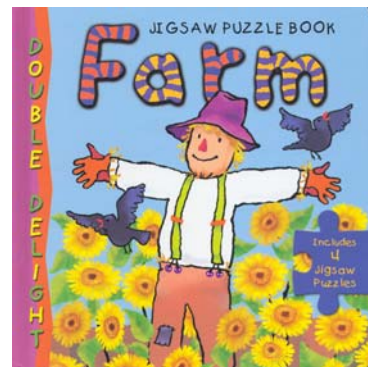
Follow the Fish By Katie Price



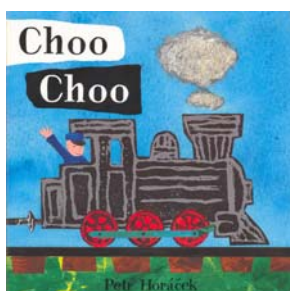
