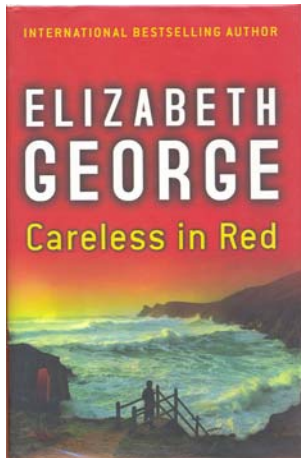

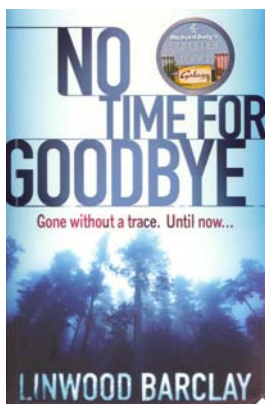
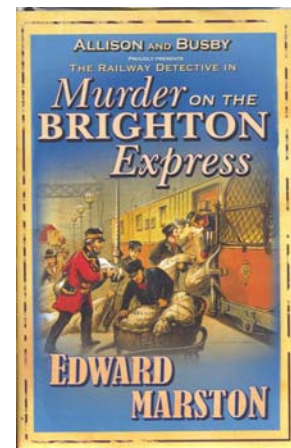


Careless in Red by *Elizabeth George*

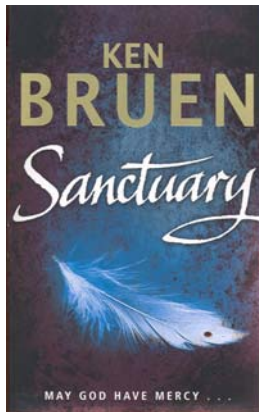
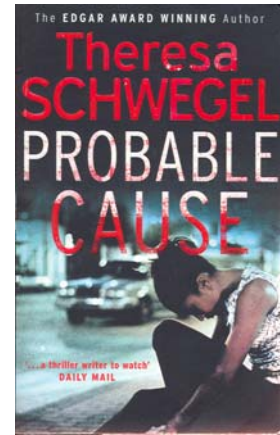


No Time for Goodbye by *Lynwood Barclay*

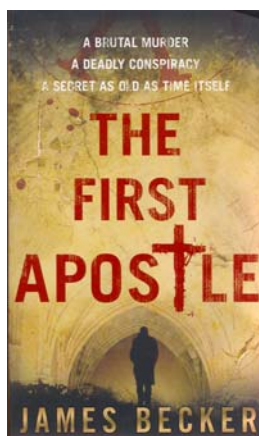


Sanctuary by Ken Bruen

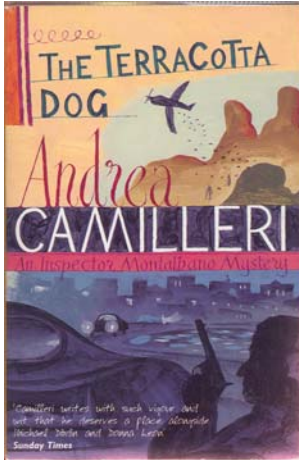
Sweet Heart by Chelsea Cain

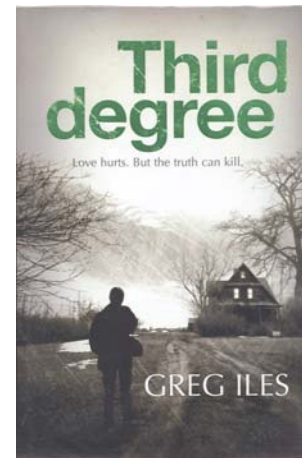


The Terracotta Dog by Andrea Camilleri
