TEMPORARY CLOSING OF ROADS

Carlow County Council, having given the required notice of its intention, have now decided to close the Local Secondary Road L7020, Killavay Cross Roads to Ballinrush Cross Roads for a period of 4 weeks from Thursday 5th November 2009 to facilitate the upgrading of the water main "Ballinrush Group Water Supply Scheme", the works will effect locals for the first 1.2km along the local secondary road from Killavay Cross Road (Shangarry Cross Roads).

The proposed alternative routes are as follows:-

Local Access will be maintained and entry will be by either Myshall to Killavay Cross Road or Myshall to Ballinrush Cross Road and or by reverse route.
