Carlow County Council invites tenders for the construction of extensions to houses at various locations throughout the County, in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by Carlow County Council. The tender documents can be obtained from the **Housing Section, Tullow Civic Offices, Inner Relief Road, Tullow, County Carlow** from **Friday 28th August 2009**

Construction of Extension & Refurbishment of house at:-

A fee of €127 per set is payable for the tender documents which is refundable on receipt of a bona-fide tender not subsequently withdrawn.

The successful tenderer will be required, to produce the specified insurance and to enter into a contract embodying the usual conditions. He will be required to comply with Tax Clearance Certification Procedures, Health and Safety legislation requirements and to be a subscriber to the Construction Industry Federation Sick Pay/Pension Scheme.

Where any sub-contractors are employed it will be the responsibility of the main contractor to ensure that the said sub-contractors are in possession of either a bona-fide C2 Certificate or a Tax Clearance Certificate.

The Council does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender received.

Carlow”** must be returned to **Senior Executive Officer, Corporate Services, Carlow County Council, Athy Road, Carlow**. Closing Date and time for receipt of tenders is **5.00 p.m. on Monday 28th September 2009**
