### **7.1 Standing in the name of Cllr. Andrea Dalton**

"This motion requests Carlow County Council to explore the provision of park and ride area near Junction 5 on the motorway (Tinryland) as there is an unused parcel of land owned by the Council near here. The motion would like to see this land assessed for suitability for a park and ride area and if deemed suitable progressed to the development of same. This motion is brought to County Council level as this area straddles 2 Municipal Districts - Carlow and Tullow"

### **7.2 Standing in the name of Cllr. Adrienne Wallace**

"This council notes that the government set an annual target of 70,000 retrofits to a B2 rating but have only achieved 28,800 under the National Residential Retrofit Plan and that there is an average of a two year wait for households applying for the Better Energy Warmer Homes Scheme. As such this Council will write to An Taoiseach, Minister Eamonn Ryan, and Minister Malcolm Noonan to urge that the Government's National Retrofitting Plan is revised to ensure it is accessible for people on lower incomes and delivered in a timely fashion with consideration to the climate emergency we are in.

In addition, this council will ask the department to introduce schemes to allow private homeowners to opt-in to retrofitting when social housing in their area is being upgraded. This could save time and money and help meet ambitious retrofitting targets.
