“That Carlow County Council initiate the design and provide plans for a bridge at the by-pass road between Royal Oak Road and the Borris Road in Bagenalstown. This is necessary due to increased traffic and the need for further industrial development in the area.”

Standing in the name of Cllr. Fergal Browne

“That Carlow County Council re-affirms its commitment to supporting and further improving the facilities at Duckettsgrove and calls on Carlow Development Partnership to review their role in same.”

Standing in the name of Cllr. Ken Murnane

“That Carlow County Council calls on Irish water to clarify its commitment relating to water and sewage lines which pass through houses, gardens and yards installed by Carlow County Council in housing estates over the last 50 years. Normal wear and tear of these systems will result in breakdowns and will require maintenance. Householders should be exempt from these repair costs as the pipe for repair will be serving a whole housing estate or at minimum a line of adjacent houses. Home owners or tenants cannot be responsible for maintaining a system that was installed, where the pipes are laid inside the property border as a community system. A commitment from Irish Water is urgently required to allay resident fears and to carry out the necessary repairs in the Carlow area.”
