The young people involved have given expression to their experiences, through Spoken Word, of the last 12 months. These unique and brilliant pieces by the young writers will be brought to you on Cruinniú na nÓg. Watch out for Pop up Poetry with and by the young people of Carlow around the Town on the day.

## MAKING KIN -

## Imagining Bodies of the Future IN PERSON WORKSHOPS @VISUAL

Imagine if your future body was part machine, part human, part mushroom and part butterfly, what could you do?

These workshops, inspired by a new artwork by Barbara Knezevic and the Woman in the Machine Exhibition, will explore how we are connected to the natural world.

During the workshops, children will make cyanotype prints on fabric.

Cyanotype is a photographic process that produces a beautiful blue image when exposed to light. Workshops will also include foraging and collage. These fabric prints will then be sewn together to make a shelter that will be used for public workshops this Summer at VISUAL.
