#### 3 Consideration of Reports and Recommendations

#### 3.1 Municipal District of Tullow – Area Engineer's Report was circulated.

Work due to commence on Main Street, Tullow was welcomed by the Members. It was noted that most of this work will be carried out at night to minimise disruption. All Utilities have been notified of proposed work and there are no objections to updating of facilities.

Safety in Ballon Village – some improvements have been noted in the last two years – however it was agreed to review with TII, taking into consideration increase in traffic.

Graiguenaspiddeogue – there are no plans for installation of an island at this location at present, however, the location is currently being assessed to improve safety.

Funding has been received to upgrade lights at Carrigduff with work due to be finished in the next 6-8 weeks.

LIS allocation proposals which were circulated, in the sum of €200,000, were agreed for 2020.

#### 3.2 Taking in Charge of Estates Progress Report

Ms. Fiona O'Neill circulated report to the Members and it was noted that 23 developments have yet to be taken-in-charge. There is no funding from the Department to assist in this process. All of these estates have been inspected with a small number of requests from Residents for their estate to be taken-in-charge. Estimated funding requirement is €800,000.

#### 3.3 National Broadband Plan – Municipal District of Tullow

Members were given a presentation on the current developments in the role out of National Broadband Service for Carlow from Eoin Lyng, Head of IS. The members acknowledged the work of the IT Department in the role out of this Programme. A number of concerns were raised such as:-

- Poor phone signal in areas
- Difficulties with remote working from home due to poor service
- The requirement for more infrastructure

It was noted that the tender process is completed and the roll out of the upgrade will be completed by 2026.
