N81 TULLOW FOOTBRIDGES SCHEME AND ASSOCIATED ROAD RECONFIGURATION WORKS

In accordance with Part 8, Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 as amended notice is hereby given that Carlow County Council has prepared plans and documents in regard to proposed new pedestrian footbridges on both sides of the existing Slaney River Bridge in the townlands of Tullowphelim & Tullowbeg, on the N81 through Tullow, Co. Carlow and road configurations and improvements to enhance both pedestrian and vehicular safety in the vicinity of the bridge. The proposed development which is known as the N81 Tullow Footbridge will include: -

- **Construction of new pedestrian footbridge on both sides of the existing N81, Slaney River Bridge**
- **Minor alterations to bridge parapet wall at all four corners of the existing bridge structure to facilitate the new pedestrian walkway**
- **Relocation of existing steps and re-alignment of bridge approach boundary wall at north west corner of bridge structure**
- **Reconfiguration of the existing N81/R725 (Thomas Traynor Road) Junction.**
- **Reconfiguration of the existing N81/Hawkins Lane Road Junction.**
- **Reconfiguration of the existing Hawkins Lane/R725 (Thomas Traynor Road) Junction.**
- **No Right or Left turn from the N81 on to the R725 (Thomas Traynor Road)**
- **No Right turn from the R725 (Thomas Traynor Road) on to Hawkins Lane**
- **Hawkins Lane will become one-way from its junction with the N81 (Abbey Street) to its Junction with the R725 (Thomas Traynor Road)**
- **The R725 (Thomas Traynor Road) will be one way from the junction of Hawkins Lane to its junction with the N81 (Abbey Street).**

The Slaney River Bridge in the townlands of Tullowphelim & Tullowbeg is a protected structure on the Record of Protected Structures (RPS) within the current Carlow County Development Plan 2015 - 2021 (Ref No CW82, NIAH 10400325) and is within the archaeological inventory of Carlow (CW 008-045).

Similarly the Methodist Church/Museum, in the townland of Tullowphelim is a protected structure on the record of Protected Structures (RPS) within the Carlow County Development Plan 2015-2021 (Ref No CW85, NIAH 10400324) and is within the archaeological inventory of Carlow (CW 008-045).

Plans and particulars of the proposed development will be available for inspection or purchase at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy during normal opening hours Monday to Friday, excluding bank holidays, at Tullow Civic Offices, Link Road, Tullow, Co. Carlow and Carlow County Council, County Buildings, Athy Road, Carlow for a period from Wednesday 18th October 2017 to Wednesday 29nd November 2017 inclusive.
