### **Notice of Proposed Burial Ground Byelaws 2021**

Carlow County Council's current Burial Ground Bye-Laws came into effect on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2008. The Bye-Laws regulate and control the use of Burial Grounds under the control or in the ownership of Carlow County Council. Notice is hereby given in accordance with Part 19 of the Local Government Act 2001 that Carlow County Council proposes to amend these Bye-Laws and draft Byelaws have been prepared. The adoption of the Bye-Laws is a reserved function of Carlow County Council.
