NOTICE OF PROPOSED ADDITION TO THE RECORD OF PROTECTED STRUCTURES IN THE CARLOW COUNTY DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2015-2021

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 54 and Section 55 of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, that Carlow County Council proposes the following addition to the Record of Protected Structures in the Carlow County Development Plan 2015-2021, in respect of the following structure listed below:

RPS Ref. CW77 - Lime Kiln, Former Sugar Factory, Athy Road, Carlow.

This structure was not recommended by the Minister for inclusion on the Record of Protected Structures, as part of the NIAH Survey of Architectural Heritage for County Carlow, 1999.

Submissions/observations should be clearly marked 'Proposed addition to the RPS in Carlow County Development Plan 2015 – 2021'. Please note that late submissions will not be considered.
