Lower Borris Traffic Management Scheme Phase 1

Carlow County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994 as amended by the Public Transport Regulation Act, 2009 (Section 46), hereby gives notice of proposals pertaining to the following development:

- Traffic calming measures in the approach roads to Borris Vocational School
- Construction of new footpaths to enhance the safety of pedestrians in this area
- Construction of new footpaths to facilitate safer access to Borris Vocational School for students
- To improve flow of traffic at busy school times by introducing a one-way system on the minor road running by Borris Water Treatment Plant, L-30068
- To improve road safety at junction between the minor road running by Borris Water Treatment Plant, L-30068 and the Regional Road, R702 by introducing a one-way system in the direction of the Viaduct
- Provision of a pedestrian crossing at Borris Vocational School
- Provision of additional street lighting.
- Installation of signage and road markings.
- Landscaping
