Proposed Road Safety Improvement Works on the Northern Environs of Bagnelstown

Carlow County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994 as amended by the Public Transport Regulation Act, 2009 (Section 46), hereby gives notice of proposals pertaining to the following development:

- Traffic Calming measures on the Regional Road R-705 at Dunleckney on northern outskirts of Bagnelstown.
- Construction of new footpaths to enhance the safety of pedestrians in this area
- Construction of new footpaths to facilitate safer access for walking route on Northern Environs
- To encourage greater pedestrian usage on this section of road.
- To promote and facilitate outdoor activities such as walking
- To improve road safety at junction between the R-705 and L-3030, junction between L-3030 and L-7143 and junction between L-7143 and L-3044
- Provision of a pedestrian crossing at junction between the R-705 and the L-3030
- Installation of signage and road markings along the R-705, L-3030, L-7143 and L-3044
- Landscaping works and biodiversity enhancement.
