

European Communities (Drinking Water) (No. 2) Regulations 2007 EXEMPTED SUPPLIES

Under the European Communities (Drinking Water) (No. 2) Regulations 2007 the EPA is the supervisory authority for all water intended for human consumption supplied by Carlow County Council or by any person acting on behalf of Carlow County Council.

In all other cases of water supplied for human consumption Carlow County Council is the supervisory authority. However Regulation 3 of the European Communities (Drinking Water) (No. 2) Regulations 2007 states that the following water supplies are exempt from supervision under the legislation:

1. private wells serving domestic dwellings, and
2. small group water schemes (serving less than 15 houses) with no commercial activity.
