**NOTICE OF RATES HAVING BEEN MADE**

**Notice is hereby given that the County Rate has been duly made on the property rateable thereon in the County of Carlow.**

**The Annual Rate on Valuation for the ordinary expenditure of Carlow County Council for the services of the financial year from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2015 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2015 is sixty nine point five five seven (€69.557).**

**BASE YEAR ADJUSTMENT (BYA)**

Notice is hereby given, that in accordance with Section 29 of the Local Government Reform Act 2014, the Base Year Adjustments (*BYA*) are to be applied for the local financial year ending on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 2015 in the following manner. The Base Year Adjustment (*BYA*) in Column 2 of the table below, calculated by reference to the Annual Rate on Valuation adopted by Carlow County Council at the Statutory Budget meeting of 21<sup>st</sup> November 2014 shall be applied as either discount or levy (*as the case may be*) to rate demands to be issued to ratepayers in the specified area identified in Column 1 of the table below.

Former Carlow Town Council Rating Area	(+) 4.19
Former Carlow County Council Rating Area	(-) 3.76

The Rate Books are now in my custody and may be inspected by any person affected thereby at the Offices of Carlow County Council, Athy Road, Carlow between the hours of 10.00 am and 4.00 pm exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays. **The said Rates will be payable from and after the publication of this Notice.**

Under Section 7(1) of the Local Government (Financial Provisions) Act, 1978, any person who is aggrieved at the failure of a Rating Authority to make him/her an allowance under the Act or who believes that he/she is entitled to a different allowance to that made to him/her may, within two (2) months of the date of making the rate, request the Rating Authority in writing to grant the appropriate allowance. In case the request is not complied with within 28 days, the person may, within four (4) months of the date of the making of the rate, apply to the District Court to have the appropriate allowance made.

The above rates were made on the 3rd March 2015. Any request in respect of them under Section 7(1) of the Local Government (Financial Provisions) Act, 1978, must therefore be made to Carlow County Council not later than 3rd May 2015. Any

application to the District Court under the same provision must be made not later than 3rd July 2015.
